AMOK adjective: Possessed with a murderous or violently uncontrollable fury. An apt description for the robots guarding the space station AMOK. They are AMOK, and only cool skill on your part earns maximum points.

SCORING

Three attackers score for each hit:

GREEN Robot	5pts
BLUE Robot	10pts
RED Robot	15pts
BLACK Robot	35pts

Bonus points are earned after clearing all four rooms.

1500 points add an extra attacker to scourge the Robots again.

LOADING

Please see loading instructions.

PLAYING

You can run and fire using an ATARI type joystick or keyboard keys:

U runs up

H runs left J runs right

N runs down

The joystick allows diagonal runs. You may fire only while running!
To fire, press the SHIFT key or the joystick button.

SKILL LEVELS

To select skill levels 1 thru 9, press FUNCTION KEY f1 repeatedly.

START PLAY

Start by pressing FUNCTION KEY f8. If you lose all three attackers, press f8 to start Again. By pressing f1 before pressing f8, you may also change the skill level at this time. If AMOK does not start in this way, reload from the tape.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTALLING UMI CARTRIDGES

TO INSTALL IN THE VIC

1. Turn the VIC's power off.
2. Face the front of the computer.
3. Grasp the cartridge with the label side up and readable. (The circuit board edge should be behind the protective hood).
4. Holding the cartridge at a slight angle and with the label up, insert it into the center of the memory expansion port. (See your computer manual for the location of the memory expansion port).
5. When the cartridges circuit board edge is centered in the connector inside the computer, press it into place slowly and firmly. DO NOT FORCE OR POUND THE CARTRIDGE INTO POSITION.
6. When the cartridge is in place:
 - a. It should be centered in the opening.
 - b. Its edge should be parallel to the back edge (or face) of the VIC.
 - c. Part of the label can be read when looking down on the cartridge from the front of the computer.
 - d. It should be firmly seated.
7. Turn the VIC's power on.
