### TO START

### **Diskette**

Make sure that the power is off to your computer. Turn on the power to your T.V. and disk drive #1. Wait for the red "drive busy" light to turn off. Insert the diskette and close the disk drive door. Now turn on the computer. The program will load and run automatically.

### Cassette

Insert the cassette into your tape player and press play. Hold down the START key and turn on your computer. When you hear the "buzzer," press RETURN. The tape will load and run automatically.

Connect a joystick to controller jack #1. A second joystick may be attached to jack #2. Press the START key or joystick button to begin.

# Object

The object of **PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY** is to move a rabbit across a highway jammed with cars. When you reach the beach you must jump from surfboard to towel and stay off the burning sand. Rolling sidewalks add to the game's difficulty. A tortoise joins the race in the two player version. You must clear two screens to complete a difficulty level. Each contestant gets three tries.
