

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

FOR PC-DOS AND MS-DOS USERS

PREPARING TO PLAY

Garfield Trivia Game requires a few minutes of preparation before beginning game play. These preparations include

- Installing DOS on your game disk by following the instructions included here.
- Formatting data disks using DOS if you plan to write your own trivia questions. All data disks must be formatted before they can be used with the program's editor. (Refer to your DOS manual for formatting instructions.)

INSTALLING DOS USING TWO DRIVES

- STEP 1.** Place your DOS disk in drive A. Use PC-DOS* or MS-DOS† series.
- 2.** Turn on the monitor and computer. The screen asks for the date and time.
- 3.** At the "A" prompt, insert the game disk in drive A. Type **INSTALL** and press **ENTER**.
- 4.** Read the screen instructions. Next, insert the DOS disk in drive B.
- 5.** Press any key to begin the installation procedure. When the procedure is successfully completed, the screen prompts "System transferred" and "1 File(s) copied."
- 6.** Designate the drive location for a data disk, then press **ENTER**.

INSTALLING DOS USING ONE DRIVE

- STEP 1.** Place the DOS disk (PC-DOS or MS-DOS series) in drive A. Next, turn on the monitor and computer. The screen asks for the date and time.
- 2.** At the "A" prompt, insert the game disk in drive A. Then type **INSTALL** and press **ENTER**.
- 3.** Read the screen instructions explaining how you must alternate the DOS and game disks in the drive to complete the installation procedure. (**Remember:** Use the game disk when prompted to insert the disk for drive A. Use the DOS disk when prompted to insert the disk for drive B.)
- 4.** With the game disk in the drive, press any key to begin the installation procedure.
- 5.** Follow screen instructions. The procedure is successfully completed after the screen prompts "System transferred" and "1 File(s) copied."
- 6.** Designate the drive location for a data disk, then press **ENTER**.


USING DOS TO LOAD THE PROGRAM

Some versions of DOS cannot be installed on the game disks. However, you can follow these simple steps to run your program from DOS each time you play the game.

- STEP 1.** Place the DOS disk in drive A and turn on the computer and monitor.
- 2.** At the "A" prompt, insert the game disk in the drive.
- 3.** Type **AUTOEXEC** and press **ENTER**. The program will load.

KEYCHART

The following keys are used in the program. The keys listed in the User's Guide do not apply to this version of *Garfield Trivia Game*.

A rectangular key with a double border and the word "SPACEBAR" in the center.

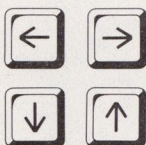
- Accesses game questions

A rectangular key with a double border and the word "ENTER" in the center.

- Registers name entry
- Registers questions and answers in editor

A rectangular key with a double border and the letters "ESC" in the center.

- Ends game early
- Returns to menu screen
- Stops printing



- Moves cursor on Enter/Edit Text screen in editor
- Scrolls thorough questions in the editor's Review mode

A rectangular key with a double border and the letters "DEL" in the center.

- Deletes characters while typing

- Accesses insert mode in editor

A square key with a double border and the letters "F1" in the center.

- Accesses editor instructions

CHANGING THE LOCATION OF THE DATA DISK

The drive location for a data disk is designated as part of the DOS installation procedure. You can change the location of the data disk at any time by placing the game disk in the current disk drive. Next, type **CHDRIVE** and press **ENTER**. Then, follow screen instructions.
