Installing from CD-ROM

For LINKS 386 CD

This installation program will first install the Recorded Player files and the Splash Screens and will then stop and ask if you wish to install the Course file (not including the flybys) to the hard drive. Since LINKS 386 CD can use the course file directly from the CD, it does not have to be copied to the hard drive. Courses played from the hard drive will render slightly faster than courses played from the CD. If you copy the course file to the hard drive, you can delete it later using the delete course feature in the game.

If you choose to leave it off the hard drive for now, you can copy it later by clicking the *Copy Course to Game Directory* button in the Catalog system. Refer to the LINKS 386 CD manual for more information.

To install this championship course for LINKS 386 CD from the CD-ROM, do the following:

Step 1: Insert the Championship Course CD into the CD-ROM drive.

Step 2: Type: D:\INSTALL [Enter] where D: is the drive letter of your CD-ROM

Step 3: Click on the LINKS 386 CD button, and follow the directions on screen.

For LINKS 386 Pro and LINKS - The Challenge of Golf

The installation program will install the Course file to the hard drive, and then for LINKS 386 Pro, it will also install the Recorded Player files and the Splash Screens. Both of these games require that the course be installed on the hard drive, and neither game can access the aerial flybys from the CD. Therefore, once the course has been installed, you will not need to use the CD to play the game.

To install this championship course for LINKS 386 Pro or LINKS - The Challenge of Golf from the CD, do the following:

Step 1: Insert the Championship Course CD into the CD-ROM drive.

Step 2: Type: D:\INSTALL [Enter] where D: is the drive letter of your CD-ROM.

Step 3: Click on the LINKS 386 Pro button or the LINKS - The Challenge of Golf button and follow the directions on screen.

For Microsoft GOLF and Microsoft GOLF version 2.0

The installation program will install the Course file to the hard drive. Both of these games require that the course be installed on the hard drive, and neither game can access the aerial flybys from the CD. Therefore, once the course has been installed, you will not need to use the CD to play the game.

To install this championship course for Microsoft GOLF or Microsoft GOLF version 2.0 from the CD, do the following:

LINKS - The Challenge of Golf button, and follow the directions on screen.

For Microsoft GOLF and Microsoft GOLF version 2.0

The installation program will install the Course file to the hard drive. Once the course has been installed, you will not need to use the disks to play the game. Floppy disk versions of courses do not contain aerial flybys.

To install this championship course for Microsoft GOLF or Microsoft GOLF version 2.0 from Floppy disk, do the following:

Step 1: Make sure you are in Windows.

Step 2: Go to the Program Manager and select FILE from the menu bar.

Step 3: From the FILE drop down menu, select RUN.

Step 4: When the dialog box appears, type: A:\UNSTALL if your floppy is drive A: or type: B:\UNSTALL if your floppy is drive B:

How to Add Courses to Links 386 CD

To add courses to Links 386 CD, do the following:

Courses on CD-ROM: (includes aerial flybys)

Option 1: Do not install on the hard drive. Play from CD only.

Even if you are not planning to copy the course file to your hard drive, you must run the course installation program to install the Recorded Player files and the Splash Screens. Follow the instructions that come with the course. This will also catalog the course for play from CD. Courses played from CD will render slightly slower than courses played from the hard drive.

Option 2: Install on the hard drive. Play from hard drive or CD.

Run the course installation program to install the Course file, the Recorded Player files and the Splash Screens. Follow the instructions that come with the course. Once the course is installed, you can play from the hard drive or from the CD. Since the flybys are not copied to the hard drive, if you want to view the flybys, you will have to put the CD in the CD-ROM drive during play.

Courses on FLOPPY DISK: (does not include aerial flybys)

Hard drive installation required.

To install the course on your hard drive, follow the course installation instructions. Older copies of these courses (manufactured before Links 386 CD was released) will not have an option to install the course for Links 386 CD. In this case, select the Links 386 Pro installation and make sure the path points to the Links 386 CD directory.
