

## LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn on the disk drive, then the monitor and computer.
- When the drive stops, insert the disk, label side up, into the drive. Close the drive door.
- 3. Type LOAD"STUNTFLYER", 8, 1 and press ◀RETURN►.

## THE MAIN MENU

## THE AIRSHOW

At the Airshow you can watch an expert stunt pilot perform a S)equence of 20 different maneuvers or an I)ndividual stunt of your choosing.

# **TRAINING**

Fly F)reestyle or attempt a S)pecific stunt. Freestyle flights can last up to five minutes, but you'll have only 60 seconds to complete a specific stunt.

Afterwards, you can watch your flight replayed. (Allow time for loading of the R)eplay program.) If you attempted a S)pecific stunt, your performance will be scored against a perfect execution of that maneuver (maximum possible score = 100; your best score on each maneuver will be displayed on the S)pecific Stunt selection menu). You may then elect to W)atch an expert; S)ee your stunt again; go to the M)ain menu, or see your N)ext stunt.

# COMPETITION

After you have attained a score of at least 50 on 15 of the 20 specific stunts which make up the training sequence, you'll be able to select C)ompetition from the main menu. Refer to your manual for a complete explanation of the competition mode.
