Quick Start

Installing Kiev

The following instructions assume your hard disk is drive C and your floppy drive is drive A. If your drive letters are different, please substitute your drive letters. Also, the following instructions are for a DOS installation. See your Windows reference manual for a Windows 3.1 or Windows 95 installation.

1. Insert **Disk 1** into the floppy drive.
2. Make sure you are in **DOS**.
3. Type **A:install**.
4. When the dialog appears, make sure Kiev stores the game where you want it. The default is **c:\kiev**.
5. Put **Disk 2** in when prompted.

Starting Kiev

1. From the **C:\KIEV>** directory type **kiev**.
2. Pursuant to the directives you will soon receive, you are hereby ordered to have a good time.

PC Requirements

5. 10 Mbytes Hard Disk Space

Kiev is a DOS based game. However, it can be run as a DOS icon using Windows 3.1 or Windows 95.

Playing Instructions

1. Start the Game.
2. Select one of the three (3) scenarios, select the computer opponent (if you are playing against the computer), and choose your nom de guerre (defaults are von Rundstedt and Kirponos for Scenario One).
3. Select Optional rules, if desired.
4. Initiate action - This consists of five phases for each player in each turn. A turn is one week.
 - Air Move (optional)
 - Ground Move
 - Air Superiority (optional)
 - Combat
 - Supply
5. For each **Phase**, perform the operation listed in the Reference Manual and Help icons.

If you selected a computer opponent during step 2 and it is the computer's turn:

- Click on the **Next Action** icon to cause the execution of the computer's next move.
 - During **Combat**, an extra click anywhere on the screen is needed to continue the game after viewing combat results.
6. Revel in the effects of your brilliant strategy or agonize over what the smart aleck computer did to you. Click on the Status icon to obtain your Personal review by Comrade Stalin or Unser geliebte Führer.
 7. Retain a clear head and repeat steps four (4) through six (6).
 8. Remember, when questions come up, try the Help icon, the reference manual, or the Status/Error Messages booklet for explanations. A help desk is operated from 7-9 pm CST at (713) 997-1209.
